FALL DISTRICT CONVENTION INFORMATION

This information is intended primarily for our new members that have not participated in a Fall District Convention before but can be useful for all of us.

This year the Convention is in Rochester, MN, during the weekend of October 23-25th.

Carl Quist has done his usual excellent job of putting together our hotel requirements and has sent them to the Rochester Convention Committee. Our hotel of choice is the Hilton Garden Inn Downtown, 225 South Broadway, Rochester, Minnesota 55904, (507) 285-1234 (only 3 blocks away from the contest site – Mayo Civic Center). Due to hotel mergers they are slow getting our confirmations sent out to each of us. At this point we are each responsible to work directly with the hotel on any changes or cancellations we individually have.

Your ticket(s) will be at the Registration/Ticket Desk in the Mayo Civic Center. It will double as a name tag and will have your auditorium seat identified on it. The Association of District Quartet Champions (ADC) show ticket is not included in tickets we purchased but can be purchased at the door of the show – usually \$10 each. You can pick up your Ticket/Name Badge Friday afternoon or when you go to the Friday night Quartet Contest. Registration is also open on Saturday, 8:30AM to 8PM.

Nothing is pre-planned for the Friday night dinner. We are on our own. I will try to get some recommendations for good restaurants. It is best to get together in small groups. Remember the Quartet Contest starts at 6PM. There are currently 22 quartets scheduled to compete – none from St. Croix Valley.

The Saturday morning buffet breakfast at our hotel has been very good in the past and is recommended. Chorus members will be required to attend our chorus warmup at the Doubletree hotel which is just a short walk from our hotel. Dress in casual clothes. We will return to our hotel at 10AM to get dressed (Full Tux w/Black Shirt, White Studs, Yellow Bow Tie & Fancy Vest) for competing in the Chorus Contest. Chorus members will be picked up at the hotel at 10:50AM. We sing 6th of 19.

After the Chorus Contest there will be Chorus Evaluations where the Judges will give us an evaluation of our performance. This is open to be attended by all members of our chorus. We will then return to the hotel to change into the clothes we will wear for our dinner and watching the Quartet Finals. Dress for dinner varies from a suit to more casual, like slacks and a sweater or sport shirt. Our buffet dinner starts at 5:30PM in a special room for us at the Civic Center. You can get there early and socialize – a cash bar will be available in the hallway. The Oshkosh Chapter will be joining us for dinner. After dinner we go down the hall to attend the Quartet Finals.

There will be an afterglow after the contest in the Civic Center where many of the contestants sing for the Convention attendees in a casual setting.

Sunday we sing at Bethel Lutheran Church at their 9AM Service. We will wear our casual uniform (i.e. Blue Blazer, Tan Slacks, Colored Shirt, etc.) and meet at the church @ 8:30AM to warmup. The church is located at 810 3rd Avenue SE, Rochester, MN 55904 (only a few blocks south of our hotel). Many of us will have a continental breakfast early and find a restaurant for a late breakfast/early lunch on the way home.
